

Tally Green HOA Tennis Court Rules

1. Only recreation members in good standing and their guests may use the tennis courts.
2. At least one TG member per court shall be present unless approval is granted from the TGHOA Board of Directors or Tennis Committee.
3. Guests do not include TG residents who are not recreation members in good standing.
4. Singles play can be reserved for 1 hour; doubles play can be reserved for 1-1/2 hours.
5. When not reserved, court use is on a first-come, first-served basis. Playing time is limited to the hours set above when others are waiting to play.
6. Tally Green tennis teams may reserve two courts at a time for league practice/play.
7. Reservations are to be posted on the bulletin board at the courts. Reservations must be made more than 1-1/2 hours prior to reservation time to apply.
8. Court reservations will be forfeited 15 minutes after posted reservation time and courts then will become available on a first-come, first-served basis. The court will then be usable by other individuals or teams.
9. Reservation conflicts shall be worked out between the parties involved.
10. Tally Green teams may bump another Tally Green team practice court time for making up rained out home matches. A courtesy call in advance to the other team's captain should be made and the makeup scheduled time is to be reserved on the court schedule.
11. Teams cannot bump individual players who have reserved a court for a rain make up match to be played, unless a prior agreement is reached by the appropriate team member and the individual player who has reserved the court.
12. Time of Play: 7am to 11pm daily. Last group off the courts is responsible for turning off the lights. Lights are to be out promptly at 11pm (county ordinance).
13. Proper tennis shoes (non-marking) and tennis attire should be worn on the courts.
14. No bikes, hot-wheels, roller skates, skateboards (including RipStiks and Scooters), toys or chairs are allowed on the courts. No children are allowed on the courts unless playing tennis. Parents are encouraged to keep children:
 - a. Off the nets
 - b. Quiet and under control during ALTA matches
 - c. From playing in the mulch and landscaping near the fenced area around the court.
 - d. From playing in the drinking fountain
 - e. And to have children respect the grounds and neighboring property.
15. Pets are not allowed in the tennis areas.
16. Tennis etiquette (i.e. no swearing, racquet throwing, spitting etc.) is required at all times.
17. Court lights are to be used for tennis playing only, unless the Tennis Committee has granted permission for other uses. Use only the on/off switch below the breaker box.
18. Use of tennis court trash facilities is strictly for garbage generated at the tennis court and is not for personal use.

Violations:

Failure to comply with these policies could result in action taken by any adult Recreation Member or by the TG HOA Board. Any TG HOA Recreation Member has the authority to remove violators and to recommend suspension of chronic violators. This could include suspension of privileges for the remainder of the day or longer for multiple offenses or a fine or both. Action is as follows:

1st Offense: Suspension of privileges for the remainder of the day with written warning by Tennis Chairperson.

2nd Offense: Suspension of privileges for a week and a \$25 fine per offense as written by the Tennis Chairperson and enforced by the TG HOA board.

3rd Offense: Suspension of privileges for a month and a \$25 fine per offense as written by the Tennis Chairperson and enforced by the TG HOA board.

Subsequent offenses: Revocation of privileges for the remainder of the HOA calendar year and a \$25 fine per offense as written by the Tennis Chairperson and enforced by the TG HOA board.

Any expenses incurred by the HOA in collection of these fines are subject to Article 6 Section 3 of the Tally Green HOA Covenants (Declaration Regarding Tally Green Subdivision and Tally Green Homeowners Association, dated 09/27/1995.)
